SCHOLARSHIP Eligibility & Qualifications Requirements

ELIGIBILITY

- . Available to members of the Saskatchewan Trappers Association (S.T.A.) or immediate family. (Memberships must be current for a minimum of 1 year).
- . Grandchildren may be sponsored by Grandparent but they must also be a member of the S.T.A. Sponsorship must be completed by the Grandparent on the application.
- . Preference will also be given to applicants whose parents or guardians have been and are currently active members of the Saskatchewan Trappers Association.
- . Consideration will be given to all applicants from a family of an active trapper or related background.
- . You are only allowed to receive the scholarship once.

QUALIFYING INSTITUTION

Plan to attend any accredited four-year college or university, a two-year campus which is part of an accredited technical college in the Province of Saskatchewan, Alberta or Manitoba. Preferences will be given to students attending in one of the following fields:

- . Environmental Sciences Forestry
- . Forestry
- . Biology
- . Fields related to Wildlife Management
- . Natural Resources
- . Or any other life science major preferred.

CRITERIA FOR EVALUATING APPLICANTS

1. Academic achievement- (Please Note: The awards are not given necessarily on scholastic standing)
2. Student involvement in activities to include: STA programs, trapping, school programs, community service.
3. Work experience
4. Essay: Applicants must submit an essay, along with their application, pertaining to their views related to Fur Bearer Management. 500 - 1,000 words will be sufficient.

DATE OF GRANTING OF SCHOLARSHIPS

The scholarship of \$1000.00 will be granted and paid in one or two instalments (of \$500.00 each) based on academic terms beginning in the August/September time period and January/February confirmation. (If a student is no longer enrolled in the second term the second part of the scholarship will be awarded to the runner up applicant.)

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORMS

Applicants must be enrolled in a Fall 2017. Proof must be provided.

Completed applications must be postmarked by April 30th, 2016 to be eligible for consideration to the Saskatchewan Trappers Association at the address below:
