



Donate Specimens to the Royal Saskatchewan Museum

People can happen upon dead animals by chance or as part of their activities. The RSM wants everyone to salvage specimens and donate them to the museum.

As the keeper of the Provincial Collections in natural history, the RSM depends on donations to permanently document the province's natural history and ensure that specimens and their data are forever available for scientific study.

How to Donate:

1. Put the specimen and a label (when and where) in a plastic bag, and freeze it.
2. Bring the specimen to the front desk of the RSM during business hours or contact Dr. Ray Poulin (Curator of Vertebrate Zoology) to make other arrangements.
