The public health order imposed to protect Saskatchewan residents from the transmission of COVID-19 allows licensed trappers who operate inside the Northern Saskatchewan Administration District (NSAD) to travel to the NSAD for the purpose of attending to the trap line.

The licensed trapper may be required to provide a copy of a valid license to be granted entry to the NSAD.

This letter does not grant access to communities within the NSAD.

This letter authorizes movement in the NSAD for a specific purpose, should you travel outside of that purpose you may be subject to enforcement, including but not limited to financial penalties.

While at in the NSAD, you will be required to observe the guidelines outlined in the Re-Open Saskatchewan Plan which can be found online at Saskatchewan.ca – this includes the need to strictly observe social distancing requirements, limit all public and private gatherings, enhance cleaning and disinfection practices and increase hand washing.

This decision will responsibly manage pressure on community services and continue to mitigate the risk of transmission of COVID-19.
