Thank you for your letter and information on the current challenges being experienced by the province's trappers in getting their products to market. Saskatchewan has a long history in the fur trade and it is disappointing to hear that trappers are having so much difficulty selling their furs.

While the Government of Saskatchewan does not provide direct financial supports such as grants or subsidies to businesses in the province, there are other external programs in place that may be of assistance. I encourage you to continue to work with Doug Howorko from the Ministry of Trade and Export Development's Indigenous Economic Development Branch regarding financial supports that may be available for northern trappers.
